If you would like to take our mastery classes but purchased your machine elsewhere, the standard hourly rate will apply for classes listed in this mailer (\$10/hour). If you schedule a one-on-one for instruction, the private lesson rate of \$40/hour will apply.

NOTE - Mastery classes are grouped by machine brand and model (i.e. 8-series, 3-series, etc.) with the exception of embroidery instruction which may be grouped together within a brand.
