





### **Class Policies:**

- 1. Classes fill quickly! Register early to guarantee your spot. Payment of the class fee is required to register.
- 2. The Quilting Bee typically accepts only 6 students per class. If a class fills, we can place you on the waiting list and contact you if an additional session is added or if there is a cancellation.
- 3. If you are unable to attend class, *please* call in advance. We are happy to transfer you to another class or issue a gift certificate! **Please Note:** we can no longer issue gift certificates if a cancellation is made the day of class.
- 4. Phone registrations are taken with credit or debit card, or gift card payment only.
- 5. No children, babies, or cell phones are allowed in class. Please help create a respectful learning environment for yourself, the instructor, and other students.
- 6. Upon registering, you will be given a supply list for each class. Most class supply lists are also available on our website. Read it completely and see what, if any, preparations need to be done ahead of time. Kits are available for some classes and fabric in kits may vary. Bring basic supplies\* to every class.
- 7. Please put your name or other identifying mark on all supplies you bring to class to prevent mix-ups.
- 8. Please arrive no sooner than 15 minutes prior to class time to set up. Classes start at listed time. Please have supplies purchased prior to class.
- 9. If you take 8 QB classes, turn in your class card to receive one FREE class (up to \$40 value).
